Some residents may have noticed a Forest Service Type 3 engine driving around the district. This is our latest acquisition to our Fire Cadre / Emergency Response Team. This unit was made available thru the Federal Excess Personal Property (FEPP) program at no cost to the district.

Rich McLaughlin was very much responsible in getting the needed paperwork, forms, requests, and board approval to get this done and this vehicle is the results and in his words,

“A big thank you to everyone involved for helping get this Type 3 to our CSD. The unit is now on our property and represents a quantum improvement to our readiness posture during fire season. Thank you all.”

We hope to equip this unit with tools and equipment to not only help protect district property from wildland fire but for all hazards and emergencies including medical calls in partnership with our contracted fire department Beckwourth Fire.

Of course there is hours of training ahead to get to that level but we are working to get there. We now have three members trained for wildland fire at the Basic 32 level and last month our fire cadre members, water department staff, and board members received BLS level CPR/AED training. Next we will be receiving Public Safety First Aid.
