Thanks for the call last week. As we discussed, just passing along the current offer for the Watt and PFE Road Intersection Improvement Project.

The project is unfortunately unable to replace the existing fencing as CCW. Although, we have reviewed your request for wrought iron in lieu of chain link fencing across the remainder of the frontage and the project is willing to cover the costs for the fencing changes. The main difference in the calculations below from the appraisal, is below includes the reduced TCE area as well as the added costs for the chain link to be replaced with wrought iron. Additionally, the project is willing to install temporary fencing during construction, so if that is appealing to the District, please let us know and we would be happy to include that in the agreement.
