To receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) the city needs to make a plan for use of funds of approximately \$21,531.and adopt Resolution 11-25 to qualify for funds

Resolution # 11-25

Resolution Adopting a list of projects for Fiscal Year 2025-26 funded by SB 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017

WHEREAS,

Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS,

SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Isleton in Sacramento County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isleton in Sacramento County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isleton in Sacramento County, will receive an estimated \$21,531 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS,

this is the ninth year in which the City of Isleton in Sacramento County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of Isleton in Sacramento County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isleton in Sacramento County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isleton in Sacramento County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS,

the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Isleton in Sacramento County maintain and rehabilitate four streets and Citywide safety improvements throughout the City of Isleton in Sacramento County this year and potentially more of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS,

the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of Isleton in Sacramento County's streets and roads are in a "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into an "excellent" condition; and

WHEREAS,

the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

by the City Council of the City of Isleton in the County of Sacramento, State of California, as follows:
