AGENDA ITEM: 8. Request to Purchase Fire Engine and Equipment from the Graeagle Fire Protection District

FROM: Jack Rosevear

RE: Consideration to Purchase A Used Fire Engine from the Graeagle Fire District

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED BOARD ACTION:

Approximately four months ago, the primary fire engine assigned to the Portola Fire Station (Station 1) suffered catastrophic motor failure and was placed out of service. The fire engine purchased from the Chester FD was put in place of the damaged engine, and is operating well as the first out fire engine for the District. At the time of the changes, we borrowed a Type 1 engine from the Graeagle FD, which is our reserve apparatus if any of our primary trucks are out of service. The borrowed Graeagle engine was for sale and the agreement was to consider purchasing the engine at a later time. Board approval is necessary to purchase the fire engine from Graeagle FD, as a capital asset.

BACKGROUND:

Attached is the loan agreement for temporary use of the 2000 Weststates fire engine (formerly an OES fire engine purchased by Graeagle FD). The engine was deployed to Helibase standby for both the Gifford Incident (San Luis Obispo/Santa Barbara County) and the Salt 4 Incident (Fresno County). The engine earned \$55,076 in apparatus reimbursement for the two deployments. The asking price from Graeagle FD is \$15,000, which is \$9,000 for the fire engine and \$6,000 for the miscellaneous equipment, hose, fittings, ladder and radio system. The engine is currently on the BPFPD vehicle insurance policy as a borrowed vehicle with an estimated value of \$30,000.

The sales invoice from Graeagle FD is attached.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Positive fiscal impact because the apparatus reimbursements from the two out of area fire deployments far exceeds the price of the purchase. There is no budget impact and the minus the purchase price, there is an additional \$40,000 that will be placed in equipment reserves, when OES pays the invoices. The engine will continue to earn reimbursement funding, as it is the primary engine assigned for out of county deployments to major fires.

IMPACTS TO THE CUSTOMER:

Positive impacts to the customer in terms of adding a valuable apparatus to our fleet, which serves as an immediate backup, if a primary fire apparatus is put out of service for mechanical reasons.. The engine will continue to bring in OES reimbursement funds, as it is assigned as the Type 1 engine that immediately deploys for out of County fire assignments.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the purchase, as submitted.
