Gulling Street Bridge

- Phase I Riprap

Plumas County Abandoned Vehicle Effort

- Coordination with PCSO, Forest Service, and County Code Enforcement to ensure success of effort

Grizzly Ranch: Potential Request to Purchase Water Rights from City

- Staff were contacted by Grizzly Ranch to discuss the possibility of Grizzly Ranch purchasing water rights from the City
- Grizzly Ranch uses the entirety of their allocation and will need additional allocation rights for upcoming years
- Conversations are in the exploratory phase. Staff will provide a full update to the City Council once additional information is obtained.
