**AGENDA ITEM:** 5. Intermountain Disposal - Rate Increase

RE: 2026 Refuse Collection Rate Increase

### **BACKGROUND:**

Under the revised and amended franchise agreement between the City of Portola and Intermountain Disposal Company, the company is entitled to an annual rate adjustment for changes in the cost of doing business, consistent with Section 5.3 of the agreement.

The adjustment for increases of the cost of doing business is based on U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics and the U.S. Energy Information Administration data for consumer indices and fuel price changes over a one-year period (August 2024 to August 2025). Specifically, the two federal agency statistics used to calculate the annual increase are:

- Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for All West Urban Consumers, Non-Seasonally Adjusted; and
- Energy Information Administration California No. 2 Diesel Retail Prices.

Staff calculated the inflation and diesel fuel increases using August 2024 and August 2025 federal data and the calculation procedure stated in section 5.3 of the franchise agreement. The combined CPI/Diesel Fuel rate increase is 3.16%. Intermountain Disposal's accounting firm VT Accounting Associates separately calculated the CPI and Fuel increases and agreed with our calculations.

### **Transfer Station Fee Increases**

The Plumas County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 25-9025 on June 10, 2025, which increased disposal fees Delleker Transfer Station by 4.42% (effective July 1, 2025). IMD seeks to increase refuse collection rates for the transfer station increase, consistent with section 5.5 of the franchise agreement – Pass-Through Costs.

To determine the percentage of the transfer station increase to pass-through to the refuse collection rates, IMD provided financial information for calendar year 2024 prepared by VT Accounting Associates. VT states IMD had total refuse collection revenue of \$517,413 and disposal fees at the transfer station of \$130,598 in 2024. Disposal cost (\$130,598) as a percentage of revenue (\$517,413) is 25.24 percent.

To calculate the transfer station fee increase to the 2026 refuse collection rates, we multiply the transfer station increase (4.42%) by the percentage cost of refuse disposal (25.24%). The result is a 1.12% increase for trash disposal services, effective January 1, 2026.

Proposed 2026 refuse collection rate sheets and the federal data sheets are attached.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council review the proposed 2026 refuse collection rates and direct staff to commence the Proposition 218 process to approve the new rates. Following written notification of the proposed 2026 rates to property owners and tenants in Portola, there is a 45-day public comment period. Staff anticipates a public hearing on the 2026 rates at a city council meeting on December 10, 2025 to consider written protests to the proposed rate increase.




