General Updates

Gulling Street Bridge

- Request made to Caltrans on 10/08/2025 to perform an underwater dive inspection and any pertinent inspections post riprap placement
- 10/15/2025: As-built documents provided to Caltrans as requested
- Follow up made to Caltrans on 10/28/2025 for the anticipated schedule for inspection(s).
 - Staff are waiting for confirmation from Caltrans
- **Phase 2- Structural Rehabilitation Funding (Caltrans Highway Bridge Program):**
 - Caltrans staff turnover with main point of contact. City staff are now engaging with new Caltrans staff on application that was submitted in August.
 - Caltrans has confirmed City has met Caltrans deadline of 11/30/2025
 - **Caltrans Next Steps:**
 - HBP Managers review applications and prioritize
 - 2026 Winter/Spring: List is compiled on bridges programmed into the program
 - City can request a meeting with HBP Managers after the list is published to discuss available options
 - Caltrans has indicated that they believe the bridge should be a “fairly high priority”
 - Engineering team is exploring additional funding streams to increase available options for this project

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Caltrans Highway 70 Work

- Staff has expressed a variety of issues with the overall approach taken by Caltrans to the Project Manager
 - Safety concerns over the lack of effective traffic control
 - Disruption to residents and businesses without advanced notice
 - Depositing of debris into City manholes
- Staff met with Caltrans team on 11/04/2025 to discuss the above
 - Staff has requested that Caltrans scope and video all the City systems potentially affected by their work
 - Any resulting required actions (jetting, repairs, etc.) would need to be addressed by Caltrans
 - Caltrans agreed to the request and will provide all supporting documents to the City to confirm full resolution to any issues identified

Public Works

Dedicated Pavement Rehabilitation Crew

- Team completed pavement rehabilitation on all three of the targeted areas this season:
 - Gulling Street Bridge- Middle Section
 - South Gulling Street and Commercial Street
 - Gulling Street near the intersection of Gulling Street and East Riverside Ave
- Project updates have been provided on City website and a further detailed update will go out with next quarterly newsletter

General

- **Water Leak Repairs**
 - Sierra Steet water line lateral replacement occurred week of 10/27
- **ARPA Grant: Water Fountain Install at Riverwalk**
 - Staff began trenching the water line along the Riverwalk
 - Water fountains will be installed next spring
- **Lake Davis Transmission Line**

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- State is inspecting the line per City's request as part of the potential transfer of ownership
- State will need to address any issues found during inspection

Winter Season Preparations Underway

- Equipment is receiving preventative maintenance
- Water Treatment Plant has been winterized
- Supplies for the season are being ordered
- Winterization of all parks including sprinkler system is completed
