Summary of Discussion

- Legal risk: California's AB 434 and the Unruh Civil Rights Act are driving PDF accessibility enforcement.
- Your inventory & pricing: 253 PDFs / 1,449 pages → Essentials plan (2,000 pages) at \$100/month. Rate can align with your budget cycle and remains locked despite growth.
- How DocAccess works: Original PDF's stay the same; users can toggle an on-demand WCAG 2.1
 AA HTML transcript for screen readers, no manual tagging required.
- Key features:
 - Aira 24/7 live visual interpreter for complex visuals (maps, charts)
 - Al-powered search/Q&A (answers only from the document)
 - Digital Table of Contents for quick navigation
 - 150+ language translation (future-proofing for anticipated Brown Act updates)
- Why now: Manual remediation is \$7/page and time-intensive; DocAccess automates compliance at about \$0.05/page/month for continuous coverage.
