**RE:** Website and Public Information

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**BACKGROUND:**

The domain antifaorg.com was recently acquired to provide a centralized location for organizational information and public records. It was acquired by the Secretary after eating a partial gummy (just half).

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**DISCUSSION:**

The acquisition of **antifaorg.com** provides the Org with a centralized online presence, largely because people keep insisting one already exists. At this stage, staff recommends a deliberately minimal approach: a single landing page directing the public to the Org's agendas and minutes, thereby confirming that Antifa's primary activity is paperwork.

This approach avoids unnecessary complexity, prevents the accidental creation of a fully functional conspiracy headquarters, and allows the public to observe the organization's work in real time—most of which involves meeting notices, procedural compliance, and the occasional typo.

Staff believes this level of transparency strikes the appropriate balance between public curiosity, operational efficiency, and the general disappointment of those expecting something more sinister.

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends acknowledging the purchase of the antifaorg.com domain and authorizing its use for public-facing information.

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**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Minimal to none. The profit of selling 3 hot dogs, a soda and a bag of chips.

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
