Support Services Building will be designed/sourced/built through the generosity of community donors and the SHD Foundation. Submittal to Plumas County for permit was complete by end of 2025 with work planned to begin Spring 2026.
Financing	USDA Financing	A interim loan has been obtained from Western Alliance Bank, to be transitioned to a permanent USDA loan following completion of construction.	Approved by USDA and paid through OR13 prior to government shut down. OR14 (MH-D August + Stryker deposit), OR15 (all soft costs through September), OR16 (MH-D September), OR17 (soft costs plus MH-D October), and OR18 (soft costs plus MH-D November) were paid with interim funding approval only, at direction from USDA to keep the project moving. With USDA return-to-work, they have started their review of those ORs, having provided approval of OR14 at time of this report.
