The size and infrastructure for the HLS will be such that a Heliport approval could potentially be pursued in the future if desired.	We have received confirmation from Division of Aeronautics that the letter is adequate that was provided by the Office of the Sheriff / Emergency Services, deeming the SHD HLS a reasonable and prudent location for safe operation and committing to oversee the operations. Boldt/HGA's design is proceeding with inset lights, fencing, and lighted windsock & beacon on rooftop. No further tracking needed.

		Sierra Timber Services (STS) was retained to prepare a Timber Harvesting Plan (THP) and associated Timberland Conversion permit (TCP). This is needed in order to clear trees as needed for the development, and will also be a component of the CEQA/NEPA analysis.	Tree removal began 10/18/23, and has been completed. Letter from the Earthwork Special Inspection company BSK is pending to be provided to GC/Grading Contractor for the hand-off of grade preparation.
Wildwood Easement			
			No update from 10/26 BOD meeting except that Peninsula Fire has been contracted (T&M) to do the access/fire review. The existing easement remains, but noting that we anticipate bringing this back to BOD for input as soon as Peninsula Fire completes their review/sign-off. The easement approved by both SHD & PCCDC for potential work at Wildwood's SW corner for main access from Reynolds Rd to the planned new facility has been recorded. Design-Build Entity may have an alternate/more costeffective solution but if that is the case we can later record a retraction of the easement.
		There is an easement currently recorded across the SW corner of Wildwood in order to properly access the new site and potential for emergency access only through the North-most drive of Wildwood.	The previously-discussed potential secondary emergency access/egress at the North (Meadow Lane) is not anticipated to be needed at this timesite plans have been submitted to the County with alternate secondary access/egress behind the clinic to Brentwood.
