# General Update


The Timber Harvest is well in progress. The trees designated for removal have been cut down, the timber operators have removed stumps, deck-piled logs, and started the process of backfilling holes where the stumps were removed. The New Hospital Build Team, including representatives from Seneca, Boldt and HGA are busy working behind the scenes to finalize details needed for construction from the equipment lists, wall colors, flooring finishes to furniture and more. The team is combing through every detail to make sure it is correct. The latest meetings have revolved around furniture selections and signage for the interior and exterior of the hospital.
