General Updates

Gulling Street Bridge

- No alarm thresholds were triggered by the continuous monitoring equipment during the recent winter weather events

Caltrans Inspection:

- Caltrans performed initial inspection on 01/27/2026
- Staff waiting for final report from Caltrans
 - Reached out on 02/23 for update
- Staff will continue to collaborate with Caltrans to confirm underwater dive inspection timeline

Caltrans Highway Bridge Program (HBP)

United States Department of Transportation

○ **Caltrans HBP Next Steps:**

- HBP Manager confirmed we are on the 2026 HBP Project Prioritization- OFF SYSTEM list categorized as a "Priority 1". We are the 4th project in line for funding on the list (see list attached to CM report)
 - The program works by taking the total funding received and starting at the top of the list funding as many projects as possible with funds available
 - The Federal status of funds is currently unknown. Given this, the HBP Managers are not committing to funding

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any bridges on the prioritization lists until funding is known.

- Staff will continue to monitor the situation for any changes and will continue to follow up with our contacts at Caltrans
- Additionally, staff have reached out to our advocates at the League of California Cities to bring the matter to their attention and to request appropriate lobbying on behalf of the City
- **USDOT Next Steps:**
 - Grant application for Preliminary Engineering costs under the United States Department of Transportation Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) program was submitted on 02/23/2026
 - Applicants should be notified of status in June of 2026

Administration

Solid Waste Consultant RFP

- We have received two (2) responses to the *Consulting Services: Solid Waste Franchise and Solid Waste Ordinance RFP*
- Staff are targeting the next City Council meeting on 3/25 to bring the matter before the Council

ADA Compliance & Website

- Majority of existing PDFs on City website have been transformed into fully accessible documents to meet ADA Title II & III as well as WCAG 2.1 AA compliance
 - This was achieved by purchasing additional software provided by our City website hosting platform Streamline
 - Any new PDFs will be automatically converted
- Our .gov domain was approved by the Federal Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency and is now live

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- Any users who attempt to navigate to our .com site will be automatically routed to the .gov site
- This increases security and legitimacy as .gov sites need to be approved by the Federal government

Public Works

- Team has focused on potholing efforts throughout the City to make repairs on areas affected by winter storms
- Riverwalk Upgrades: **Funded by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding**
 - Water lines completed
 - Concrete pads being poured
 - Water fountains with bottle fillers for humans and drinking access for pets will be installed

Planning

- **Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP)- Plumas County Consultant**
 - 01/16/2026: LHMP was submitted to California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) for review
 - March 2026: Plan anticipated to be sent to FEMA for review
 - Summer 2026: Anticipated FEMA approval of LHMP
 - Post FEMA Approval: City Council to consider adoption of FEMA approved LHMP
- **Safety Element Updates**
 - Per CA SB-815, upon the next revision of the LHMP, the Safety Element shall be reviewed and updated
 - Planning consultant is currently working on the update
- **General Plan Updates**
 - Updates are forthcoming from the Planning consultant and will be presented to Council
