This is needed in order to clear trees as needed for the development, and will also be a component of the CEQA/NEPA analysis. We will continue to track this until the closure of the project with Water Control Board and handoff to monitoring within the site work Stormwater Polution Prevention Plan implementation.
Wildwood Easement			Peninsula Fire (PF)completed the initial access/fire review and provided the needed documentation for HCAI, but has some deferred items. Email was sent to PF with additional information to aim at resolving 4 out of 6 deferred items, only leaving building evacuation maps and NFPA 704 placards needing review.  Design-Build Entity has proposed alternate/more cost-effective solution and if all is approved, we can later record a retraction of the easement. We will hold off addressing this possibility until all permits are received and construction begins.
