### **Answer below:**

Equipment and PPE to be used in the Indian Valley Fire Department. This is a volunteer fire department with 19 members. We staff four fire stations in a large geographical area. Our entire district was burned over during the Dixie Fire. The town of Greenville burned up including our primary 4 bay fire station and office. Approx. 390 residences perished along with sheriff substation, ambulance quarters, library, post office, stores, gas stations, restaurants, etc. We are in the process of trying to rebuild the station in the town of Greenville. Application is in the Plumas County Planning Department for approval now. Trying to reoutfit/upgrade our new volunteers and purchase needed equipment lost when firehouse burned..
