Jaymen, attached is an updated/revised proposal. Disregard the previous proposal I sent a couple weeks back. On this proposal I show the breakdown of costs per item for the original scope of work. Before I just had a lump sum. This way everyone can see where the increases are. I then provide the same breakdown, per the original scope of work, but updated to reflect the increases since we originally bid this work. The main increase is for the change to off haul and dispose of the dirt off-site but there is an increase related to the increase in asphalt pricing. Again, this way everyone can see the breakdown and where the associated increase are. I note what the net increase is per the original scope of work.

Then it gets tricky as we are now looking at changing the curb design plus there is an additional 94 l.f., from Fir Ave. up to the grassy area, that we are now adding. That was not in the original scope. So, the alternate pricing includes that 94 l.f. that would be extra if we stayed with the "mow strip" curb. To change to a 12" tall curb I note the unit price and total. Then I deduct the original cost for the mow strip and then note the net increase. So, the overall increase above the original approved amount of \$95,370 would be \$18,205 (\$4,914 + \$14,291). Same goes for the curb-gutter, I note the unit price and total to construct that, then deduct the mow strip price along with less asphalt as the gutter pan (18") would be into the aisleway we would pave. Per the "updated" unit pricing I deduct that amount and then show the net increase. The overall increase to the original approved amount would be \$23,492 (\$4,914 + \$18,578).

Again, hope this all makes sense. Let me know if it does not and we can go over it.




