**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLETON DECLARING A CHIEF DUTY OFFICER VEHICLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY DUE TO FINANCIAL CONSTRAINTS AND AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSITION**

**WHEREAS,**

the City of Isleton owns a Chief Duty Officer Pickup a 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 VIN:1GCUDEE81PZ292247 "9300" which was purchased for \$59,560 plus taxes and associated fees: and

**WHEREAS,**

due to the City's current financial crisis, retaining this vehicle is not fiscally responsible given the need to allocate funds to higher-priority essential services; and

**WHEREAS,**

the City has determined that this vehicle is not essential to maintaining emergency response capabilities under the current circumstances; and

**WHEREAS,**

in order to ensure the financial stability of the City, the sale of this surplus vehicle is necessary to generate needed revenue to support remaining municipal operations; and

**WHEREAS,**

the City may dispose of surplus property through a sale, transfer, or auction, prioritizing sales to other public agencies when feasible;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

The Chief Duty Officer Pickup a 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 VIN:1GCUDEE81PZ292247"9300" is hereby declared surplus property due to financial necessity

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

The City Manager, or their designee, is authorized to pursue the sale or transfer of the vehicle to another public agency as a first option, or to a private entity or wholesaler if necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

The City Manager, or their designee, is further authorized to negotiate terms for the sale and ensure proceeds are used to support the City's financial obligations and essential services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

The City Council reserves the right to reject any offers or withdraw the sale if needed based on financial considerations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

The City Manager, or their designee, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to complete the sale or transfer.
