EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Update on Fire Department operations:

- -City and Fire Department are now authorized to conduct drivers license monitoring and inquiries through the DMV Employer Pull Notice system. This system allows us to maintain compliance and ensure qualified drivers are operating city and fire department vehicles at all times.
- -During the course of the sale of the 2023 Chevrolet Silverado command vehicle, our need for PPE was identified and we were able to secure 9 sets of structural turnout PPE from the City of Jackson.
- -Acquired 2000 Chevy Silverado during the course of the sale of the command vehicle from the City of Jackson. Vehicle is equipped with lights and siren and will be utilized as quick response vehicle equipped with basic life support supplies. Vehicle will enter service within the next few weeks.
- -3 new volunteers have joined the fire department roster with a mix of experience. Avery Cambria joins us as a certified EMT. Sarah Cowan has returned to the department with 8 years of firefighting experience, and Otilio Patino joins us with no firefighting experience but has already jumped right into training.
